The students who did not choose the teacher training specialisation at MA level studies can enrol in additional teacher training post-graduate studies also offered by University of Opole.

Graduate studies also prepare candidates for doctoral studies in a similar field.

Also if you want to gain proficiency in both Polish and English languages and afterwards work for multinational companies both in Poland and abroad, Polish Studies is a programme you must choose.

ADVANTAGES OF POLISH STUDIES



MA PROGRAMME

This MA graduate programme has been created for students who want to continue their journey of learning the English language. Students have the opportunity to develop, among other things, practical language skills at a high C2 proficiency level of CEFR for languages, and to deepen their knowledge of the selected field of study:

- Literary studies
- Cultural studies
- Linguistics
- Applied Linguistics: Teacher Training
- Business English
- Translation Studies

ACADEMIC LANGUAGE SKILLS

Students participate in classes of academic writing, academic text-based speaking, advanced listening, advanced grammar, academic vocabulary-oriented courses.

The English language is a language of scientists, businessmen, and diplomats. Nowadays on the labour market knowledge of foreign languages is a skill sought for by employers. Graduates from English Philology have extensive knowledge of the English language, culture, history, and literature.

Ability to speak foreign languages is a significant asset. Graduates can find employment in e.g., schools, language schools, translation bureaus, advertising companies, public relations, research institutes, and business institutions.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE PhD PROGRAMME

If you are excited by academic life, research, and eager to participate in conferences and publish your own articles – a PhD programme is a great choice for you!

Our faculty will gladly share their extensive knowledge and will provide their guidance in diverse fields of study, e.g., linguistic, historical linguistics, corpus linguistics, lexicography, literacy studies, second language acquisition, literary criticism and theory, as well as English, Irish, American or Australian literature. PhD programme in English Language and Literature lasts four years. During the first two years students should complete their obligatory courses (core curriculum), and later work on their dissertation. Every student will have a chance to gain teaching experience by giving classes within independent introductory courses or working as teaching assistants for staff members.

ERASMUS PROGRAMME

University students of any nationality can apply for Erasmus mobility and be granted a monthly scholarship ranging between 300 and 700 EUR with travel costs reimbursed as well. We strongly advise you to use scholarships for your internships too. The training scholarships are also available for you up to 12 months after graduation.

TUITION FEES

1200 EUR per year EU citizens and Pole's Card holders study free of charge
